For the pool terrace (page 104) of an estate-like residence in Northern California's wine country, David Darling needed something sophisticated with elegant lines. 10 For a classic Southwestern feeling, Navajo rugs take the place of artwork on the walls of a pavilion by John Gaw Meem in New Mexico (page 139). To dress up the walls of your own house with artful textiles, go to the Santa Fe location of the Mark Sublette Medicine Man Gallery and choose from more than four hundred Navajo blankets and rugs, including a circa-1900 example from the Ganado region of Arizona.
